

### JeCCDO's General Assembly (GA) Meeting was Held on 30<sup>th</sup> of March 2018 at JeCCDO Opportunity for Change Training Center (JOCTC) in Bishoftu

The meeting was attended by members of the GA, Board of Directors, a representative from Federal Charities and Societies Agency (ChSA), JeCCDO's management and staff.

*At the meeting, a welcoming address to the meeting participants and a brief introduction on the rationale behind the meeting session was prefaced by Mr. Tsegaye Cherenet, Chairman of the GA. Then, up on the tabled/approved agenda, the meeting meticulously discussed on each agenda.*



*As part of the agenda, JeCCDO's annual program performance report (1<sup>st</sup> of January – 31st December 2017) was presented. As it was presented, in the reporting year **222, 534 people (97,018 female)** had been benefited from JeCCDO's different program interventions, which accounted for*

***96%** achievement of the planned targets. In line with that, the budget used for the program was **76%** of the total annual expenditure and the admin share was **24%**. Furthermore, the audit report was presented by the audit firm.*
